

50. J.F. BARBER & CO. PHILLIPSBURGH PA Mfd & Ground in Germany on left tang. Clean and sharp. Celluloid handles.



51. The "RELIABLE" has Very Nice Embossed Celluloid handles in a Tortoise Shell style and a very clean blade that has not been cleaned so there is a touch of pitting on the blade. T.T.C. is inside a diamond outline on the left tang. This was made by T.T. Co., Germany. This is in Very Good and Shave-Worthy condition.



52. NON PLUS ULTRA GERMANY on left side and HOLLOW GROUND with a Crown and Sword symbols (Masonic) is etched on blade. Old Horn Handles. Old, but a Sharp Shaver.





53. The Celebrated Acme Razor is etched on the blade with scrolling. Wilbert inside a diamond is on left tang. Bottom grooves. Made after 1909 & probably from Chicago. Composite handles. Good condition.



54. WOSTENHOLM IXL. Geo.Wostenholm & Son's Celebrated IXL Razor Washington Works on left tang. IXL with a Sheaf of Grain is etched on the blade with a notched head. Wedge has Horn handles. Minor nicks on edge.



55. DURHAM DOMINO Jersey City, NJ from 1908 Celluloid handles in ivory finish.



56. Vintage Swedish. Very old Horn handles. C.W. DHALGREN; Eskiltuna PRISBELONT GARANTI 1878 81.86. is on the left tang. Unusual blade shape. Rust as shown.





57. "THE STANDARD KNIFE CO. LITTLE VALLEY, N.Y." is on the left tang. Blade is clean, quite sharp and shaveable. VG condition. No listing.



58. ONAOLA with scroll stamping on left, and ONAOLA MFG CO LOS ANGELES, CAL, also stamped on right. Clear celluloid handles. Clean in good condition.





59. G.W. DAHLGREN ESKILSTON. Frameback razor. Black celluloid handles. An old razor and not the original handles. Blade is very clean for its age.



60. FORQUIGNON with Nice black celluloid handles that are Embossed with fleur de leis design and a mans profile at the base. The blade is very clean and a sharp shaver. There is only small spotting on the right side of the blade.



61. NON ◦ XLL JOSEPH ALLEN & SONS SHEFFIELD, ENGLAND is on the left tang. Good bottom grooves. Rising Fish & TRADE MARK etched on blade. Horn handles. Very old but blade shaves like new. Nice heavy wedge with notched head. Made after 1864.



62. Another old heavy sharp shaver wedge blade in bone handles with an etched blade. "CHAMPION" etched on blade. CANTON CUTLERY CO CANTON OHIO on left. Rust & tarnish as shown. Made after 1879.



63. GEO HAW blade with Rare Aluminum Handles. Estimated from 1900. Tarnish but no rust. Sharp.



64. Detroit Favorite. The E. Morris Prosperity. 450 PROSPERITY HAND FORGED on left tang. E. MORRIS MFG. CO. DETROIT, MICH MADE IN SOLINGEN GERMANY on the right. PROSPERITY HAND FORGED also embossed on handle in red ink. Clean Celluloid handles. A sharp shaver.



65. BROTHERHOOD RAZOR. "THE AMERICANS GIVE THE RIGHT HAND OF FELLOWSHIP TO ALL NATIONS AND OWN AN UNIVERSAL BROTHERHOOD" etched on blade in scrolls and with a handshake. Composite handles in good condition with box.





66. SUPERIOR. Superior Razor, Sheffield, England on left tang. THE AMERICAN RAZOR embossed in gold on clear Horn handles. AMERICAN RAZOR etched in blade. Excellent condition. Sharp.



67. Old Wostenholm IXL. GEORGE WOSTENHOLM & SONS CELEBRATED IXL RAZOR WASHINGTON WORKS SHEFFIELD on the left tang. Heavy wedge that's very sharp. Old bone handles, one with a escutcheon plate & silver inlays.



68. Another Old Wostenholm in mottled horn handles. Different in that on the right tang is only G.Wostenholm & Son, Sheffield, Eng. An old sharp shaver.



69. LEWIS-STENGER BARBERS SUPPLY CO GERMANY on the right tang. "RELY UPON ME" is on the left. Bottom grooves. TOR on the tang but blade is a very Sharp Shaver. Black Celluloid handles.
